The Partagas factory is one of the most renowned buildings in Havana, situated in Calle Industria 520. Sadly cigars are no longer produced in the original building, the factory having been moved to the former El Rey Del Mundo building. The cigars are however still of legendary quality and the D4 is no exception. A ‘robusto’ in size it is packed with rich, earthy flavours with a subtle sweetness as an end note.

It pairs perfectly with bolder whiskies such as the Balvenie 21 year old Port Wood. This well matured whisky is finished in 30 year old ‘Port Pipes’ giving a delicious fruitiness on the palate with a very subtle hint of smoke on the finish.
